**“Roadmap to recovery”  
– a proposal for a global network of marine reserves”**

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Greenpeace, is an organization committed to the joint objectives of protection, conservation and restoration of marine systems. Accordingly, in common with a growing numbers within the scientific, political, regulatory and NGO communities Greenpeace is of the view that these objectives would be best met and served by the designation of a global network of fully protected marine reserves which would ultimately embrace 40% of the world's oceans. In order to underpin this position, Greenpeace has supported scientific work aimed at identifying candidate high seas areas for designation as marine reserves. This presentation will outline the methodology used in identifying these candidate areas and present the global map which has resulted from the application of these methods.
